

**MHSAA Board Meeting
Minutes of July 10, 2018**

The Madison High School Alumni Association (MHSAA) held its 5th Board Meeting of 2018 on July 10th at the Alumni Room of Madison Middle School (MMS). The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. by President Roy Jones ('67). Also present were Vice-President & Treasurer Rick Pharris ('75), Past President & Secretary Jerry Armour ('66), Past President Gale Andrews ('71) and Past President Sandra Hollingsworth ('61).

Minutes of Prior Board Meeting:

Jerry Armour read the minutes of the June 12, 2018 meeting. Minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer Rick Pharris presented the Treasurer's Report. He reported that, currently, the Association has \$2,346.37 in our General Fund and \$8,213.61 in the Scholarship Fund after the \$1,500.00 scholarship check for Chad Lester/Austin Peay had cleared.

2018 MHSAA Golf Tournament Committee:

The 2018 MHSAA Golf Tournament will be held Friday, October 12th at the Old Hickory Country Club course. Roy Jones stated that particulars of the tournament will be similar to our tournaments of past years. There will be prizes for the putting contest, hole-in-one, closest to the hole, winning team, etc. And, this year, MHSAA will be offering a car/motorcycle as a prize for a hole-in-one on one of the par 3 holes. The entry fee for the tournament is \$125.00 per golfer (including meal and brief program). Cost for non-golfers will be \$30.00 for the meal and program. Further details will be forthcoming from the committee [Cathy Dunn Wedekind (MHS '69), Debbie Locke (MHS '69), Roy Jones and Rick Pharris]. Proceeds from the Golf Tournament go to help fund the Scholarship Program. This year's golf tournament is sponsored by the MHS Class of 1968 in honor of their 50th Class Reunion. Gerald Grant (MHS '68) is helping organize teams of golfers from his sponsoring class.

2018 MHSAA All-Class Reunion Committee:

The 2018 MHSAA All-Class Reunion is scheduled for Saturday, October 13, 2018 (location and times are to be determined). Roy Jones reported that he is currently negotiating with Woody's in Hendersonville to hold our reunion there. Also, MHSAA is looking at the possibility of holding a "Hillbilly Day"-themed reunion at MMS. In this case, there would be a food truck outside in the parking lot area. Games such as horseshoes, cornhole toss, dunking booth, etc. would be available. Contests could include prizes for best beard, best pie, oldest car, best costume, etc.). Also planned are a sign board with a face cut-out for photos of attendees and pictures from past Hillbilly Days would be running continuously from an electronic screen. Sandra Hollingsworth is in charge of organizing the presentation of the pictures. Roy Jones will be checking on the catering. Parking will be on school grounds. And, the Alumni Room would be open to tour. Admission for the Hillbilly-themed reunion would be \$5.00/each for all attending. Additional details are forthcoming. Proceeds will go to help support the Scholarship Fund as well as General Fund needs.
