## MHSAA finds new home at Madison Art Center

The Madison High School Alumni Association has a new home.

A second floor room at the Madison Art Center now displays class composites, trophies, awards and other memorabilia from the former Madison High School.

The Madison Art Center is located on Gallatin Road in the old Madison Theater. The center features 16,000 square feet of beautifully lighted galleries with rich wooden floors, artist studios and classrooms. The center focuses on the work of local and regional artists and is a project of the Tennessee Artists Guild.

“We’re thrilled with the space the Madison Art Center is letting the Association use to display our memorabilia,” said Sandra Hollingsworth, president of the Madison High School Alumni Association. “We’ve

been looking for a location in Madison where alumni and residents can see these items displayed.”

Composite pictures for the classes of 1956, 1957, 1961, 1966 and 1967 are on display. The Association is trying to locate others.
